<p>Connection Grants</p>	<p>Projects can occur in Canada or abroad. If a proposed project is to occur abroad, the applicant must justify the project's potential to mobilize Canadian research on an international stage, and why the project must happen outside Canada.</p> <p>Co-applicants Individuals (including postdoctoral researchers) are eligible to be co-applicants if they are formally affiliated with any of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Canadian eligible postsecondary institutions; not-for-profit organizations; philanthropic foundations; think tanks; or municipal, territorial or provincial governments; or • International postsecondary institutions. <p>Collaborators Any individual who makes a significant contribution to the project is eligible to be a collaborator. Collaborators do not need to be affiliated with an eligible Canadian postsecondary institution.</p>
<p>Partnership Engage Grants</p>	<p>Co-applicants Individuals are eligible to be a co-applicant if they are formally affiliated with any of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Canadian eligible postsecondary institutions; not-for-profit organizations; philanthropic foundations; think tanks; or municipal, territorial or provincial governments; or • international postsecondary institutions. <p>Collaborators Any individual who makes a significant contribution to the project is eligible to be a collaborator. Collaborators do not need to be affiliated with an eligible Canadian postsecondary institution.</p> <p>Only one Canadian or international organization from the public, private or not-for-profit sector can be involved as a partner organization. Postsecondary institutions, including organizations or associations affiliated with them, and scholarly associations are not eligible as partner organizations.</p>
<p>Partnership Development Grants</p>	<p>Co-applicants An individual (including postdoctoral researchers) is eligible to be a co-applicant if they are formally affiliated with any of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Canadian: eligible postsecondary institutions; not-for-profit organizations; philanthropic foundations; think tanks; or municipal, territorial or provincial governments; or • International: postsecondary institutions.

	<p>Collaborators Any individual who makes a significant contribution to the project is eligible to be a collaborator. Collaborators do not need to be affiliated with an eligible Canadian postsecondary institution. Individuals from the private sector or federal government can participate only as collaborators.</p>
<p>Partnership Grants</p>	<p>Co-directors and co-applicants Individuals are eligible to be co-directors or co-applicants if they are formally affiliated with any of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Canadian eligible postsecondary institutions; not-for-profit organizations; philanthropic foundations; think tanks; or municipal, territorial or provincial governments; or • International postsecondary institutions. <p>Collaborators Any individual who makes a significant contribution to the project is eligible to be a collaborator. Collaborators do not need to be affiliated with an eligible Canadian postsecondary institution. Individuals from the private sector or federal government can participate only as collaborators.</p> <p>Partner organizations Partner organizations can be Canadian or international institutions or organizations (public, private, not-for-profit) of any type.</p>
<p>Insight Development Grants</p>	<p>Co-applicants Individuals (including postdoctoral researchers) are eligible to be co-applicants if they are formally affiliated with any of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Canadian eligible postsecondary institutions; or • International postsecondary institutions. <p>In the case of international co-applicants, the rationale for international collaboration must be clearly outlined in the application.</p> <p>Collaborators Any individual who makes a significant contribution to the project is eligible to be a collaborator. Collaborators do not need to be affiliated with an eligible Canadian postsecondary institution.</p>
<p>Insight Grants</p>	<p>Collaborators Any individual who makes a significant contribution to the project is eligible to be a collaborator. Collaborators do not need to be affiliated with an eligible Canadian postsecondary institution.</p> <p>Foreign co-applicants are not allowed.</p>

NB: Applicants (e.g., Principal investigator, project director) must be affiliated with a Canadian postsecondary institution that holds [institutional eligibility](#) at the time of application and before funding can be released. Researchers who maintain an affiliation with a Canadian postsecondary institution, but

whose primary affiliation is with a non-Canadian postsecondary institution, are not eligible for [applicant](#) status.
